The independent Local Government Boundary Commission for England is carrying out an electoral review of Surrey County Council.

The aim of the review is to make sure everyone's vote is worth roughly the same at local elections. To achieve this, we need to change the current pattern of county council divisions.

In the first stage of our review, we proposed that the County Council should have 80 councillors.

Now we're asking for evidence about your local area to help us decide a new pattern of divisions for the whole county.
